- Draslovka conducting toxicology studies
- Spencer Walse conducting efficacy, residue trials, worker exposure
- Ready for submission in late Fall
- Possible Sec. 18 for use in late fall - *Maybe*

Pesticide Label

- Label is a legal document
- Describes limits for use
- Describes rate for use
- Describes how to make applications
- Describes what not to do
- We are drafting label language that will be submitted to EPA for registration

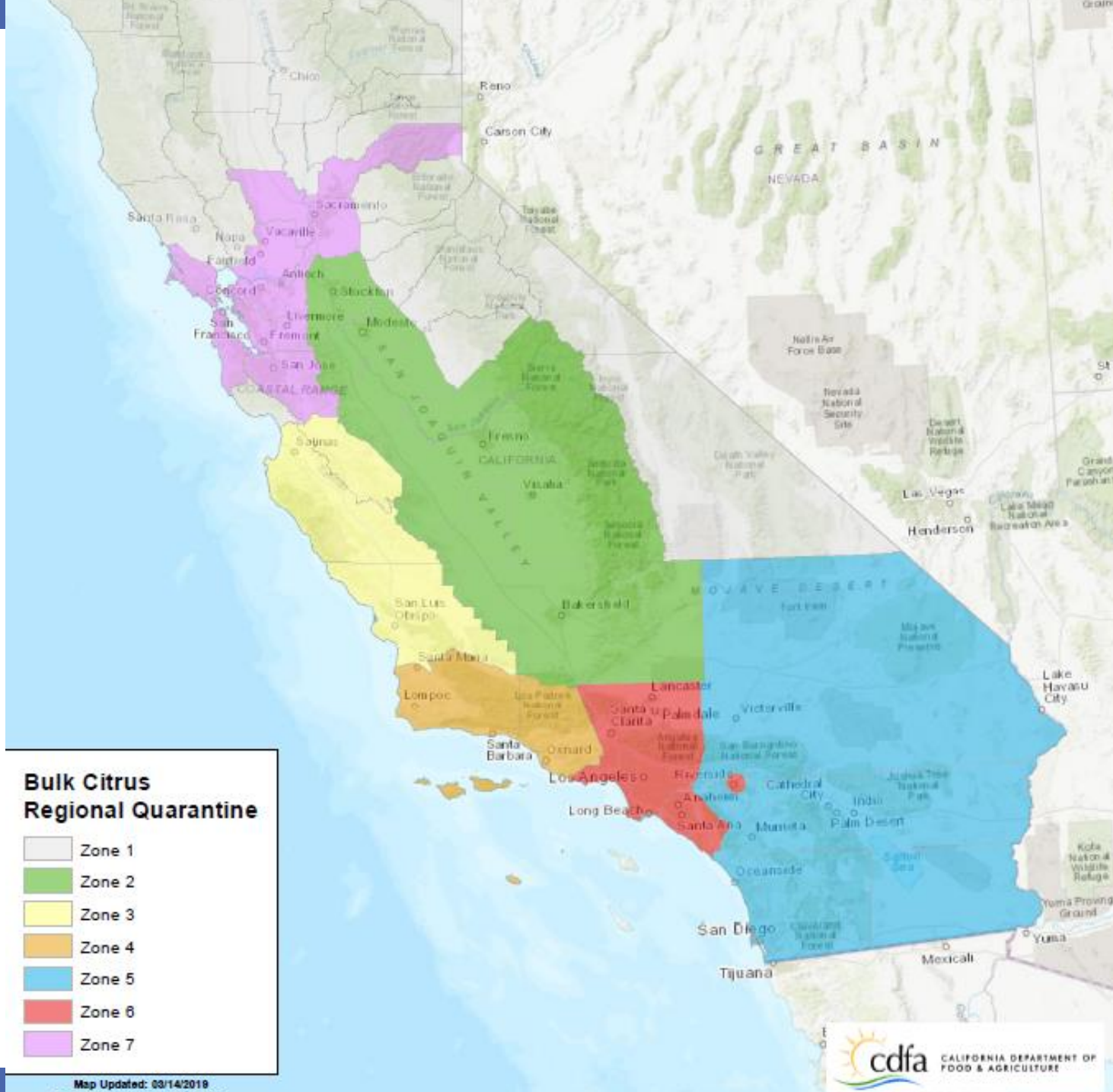
Possible Ethyl Formate Uses

Export quarantine fumigation (chamber):

- Bean thrips
- Mites
- Scale

Asian citrus psyllid use in grove:

- Bean thrips
- Mites
- Scale



Industry Input Needed

- Spencer Walse conducted commercial field trials that kill 100 percent of ACP
- Now need to know if the industry wants to use ethyl formate the way it has been tested
- Should the use be adjusted?
- Which other factors should be considered in drafting the label?
